Dark and juicy, with plum, boysenberry, raisin and fruitcake flavors backed by dark cocoa and enticing cigar smoke notes. The finish is long and fleshy. A fun, hedonistic wine. Malbec, Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah and Petit Verdot. Drink now through 2010. 9,000 cases made.—J.M.



Atemporal Blend 2007 is an assemblage of Malbec (43%), Cabernet Sauvignon (36%), Syrah (11%) and Petit Verdot (10%) from our terroirs in Valle de Uco at 1,000 m.a.s.l on the Cordillera de los Andes.

Each wine is matured separately in French oak for 12 months before being blended resulting in a complexity of aromas and flavours.
